- 1. Create a file named ".Xresources" in your home directory.
- 2. To change the background color of your terminal window, use VI to add the following line to .Xresources:

XTerm*background: color

where color is your favorite color - ex. lightblue.

- 3. Activate your changes by entering the following command into a terminal window:
 - xrdb .Xresources
- 4. Verify that the above change works by opening a new terminal window.
- 5. How would you change the foreground color?
