## Exercise 1

1. Open a terminal window.
2. Create a directory “foo”.
3. Go into “foo”.
4. Create an empty file “bar”.
5. Rename the file “baz”.
6. Find a way to change the permissions of “baz” to Owner read, Group write, and Other read.

## Exercise 2

1. Create a file named “.Xresources” in your home directory.
2. To change the background color of your terminal window, use VI to add the following line to .Xresources:

```
XTerm*background: color
```

where *color* is your favorite color – ex. *lightblue*.

3. Activate your changes by entering the following command into a terminal window:  
xrdp .Xresources
4. Verify that the above change works by opening a new terminal window.
5. How would you change the foreground color?
