

## Week 9 Homework

In this homework, we will install ftp - file transfer protocol with which you had some experience during a lab early on in the semester. You will also clean out all of the potential security threats from the default installation of mysql. Part 1

- 1) Using **apt-get** install proftpd.
- 2) In the conf file change the port for ftpd to listen on to 1xx21, where xx is your group number.

### Part 2

1) Get rid of the default accounts except for root and default databases:

- *mysql -u root -p* - to enter into command line **mysql**. Enter the password you changed to last time. You should get a prompt **mysql>**.
- *drop database test;* - delete the sample test database
- *use mysql;*
- *delete from db;*
- *delete from user where not (host="localhost" and user="root");* - delete all users other than root
- *flush privileges;*
