Though I have only emphasized the history of GNU/Linux in the first few weeks, it is important that you remember how the free software movement had started and had the key players not do what they have done, the technological world would be a very different place than it is today. I encourage everyone to at least recap on earlier lecture notes and understand some of the finer points in \*NIX history.

If you didn't realize already, the last two questions were put in at random and you were not expected to know the answers. It was an evaluation of group work and general problem solving. Given what each of the group members knew, could the members of each group work together? Keep this in mind in the upcoming weeks.
